Competition Name	Kinjarling Djinda Ngardak – 'Albany Comes Alive Under the Stars'
Brief	We need your artwork to help us promote Australia's amazing bush tucker at our Food Camp and Gala Dinner being held in Albany in November. Bush tucker is the native food (plants and animals) used by Indigenous Australians to sustain themselves for many thousands of years. It includes kangaroo, emu, crocodile, goanna, bush turkey, green ants, turtle, fish, crabs, witchetty grubs, quandong, munties, lemon myrtle, bush tomatoes, bush bananas, lily pily, bull banksia, desert limes, salt bush, wattle seeds, harsh hakea, and many more fruits, nuts and seeds. Food was seasonal and people respected traditional food rules and laws around the types of food that could be eaten, who could gather or hunt for it, how it was prepared and how it was eaten.
	Research the way that indigenous people have used the land and prepared their food for many thousands of years and explore the exciting potential for using native foods in our cooking today. Create an A3 Poster that celebrates bush foods or a bush tucker food story from the area where you live or
	from the Great Southern Region of WA where our Indigenous food conference is being held in November. The winning submission will be made into a large banner, table decorations and a menu that will be proudly displayed at the <i>Kinjarling Djinda Ngardak</i> gala dinner at the Albany Entertainment Centre on 23 rd November 2018. The artwork will also be showcased on flyers that promote KDN for the next 12 months
